1. Volunteers give their time freely to run Clanfield FC. All players are expected to show respect for Managers, Coaches and Club Officials.
2. The club strives to maintain and improve the facilities utilised. Players wishing to play and/or register for the club will treat them properly.

The Club sees football as a force for good in the community. All players and club members will show the right attitude towards the game.

COLTS

WHEN PLAYING FOOTBALL I WILL:

- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of myself and the team.
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, dive, complain or waste time.
- Treat opponents, referees, officials, managers / coaches and team mates with respect.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee.
- Never be rude to my team-mates, the other team, the referee, spectators or my coach/team manager.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – I will shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my coach/manager tells me.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

The club wants its teams to be successful. Teams will be successful if they show the right attitude:

- Players and Managers will share certain key values: Skills, fitness and teamwork can always be improved.
- Players are expected to attend training sessions whenever possible.
- If players are unable to attend they must contact their manager / coach prior to the training session.
